All classes made sure this was a fabulous success. Over 100 children met Santa in his grotto while KS2 children made sure everyone had fun playing all their games.

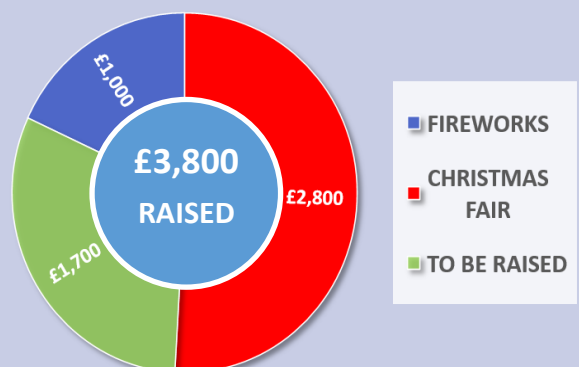


We cooked **480 Hot Dogs** —that's a lot of sausages.....
